Board Meeting Minutes
July 30, 2026**

- I. The meeting was called to order at 1:08 p.m. Present: Martin O'Brien, Mrs. Clara Green, Charles Williams and Edna Bailey
- II. Purpose of the Meeting: The meeting was held for the board to approve the remaining compliance items requiring board approval which are due to the School District of Manatee County (SDMC) by August 1, 2026.
- III. Annual School Operating Budget. The decision was made to keep the budget very close to last year. The 2026-2027 budget is based on a forecast of 65 students. Revenues are expected to exceed expenses resulting in an estimated net of \$61,000. It was noted that any necessary changes and/or updates can be made to the budget during mid-year review. The board unanimously approved the 2026-2027 Annual School Budget.
- IV. Safe-School Officer Policy: Florida schools, per the Florida State Board of Education, are required to have a policy for safe-school officer assignment outside the regular school day. This includes before and after school, summer sessions, school events and extracurricular activities. Oasis Middle School Policy includes a school guardian on school-site daily during school hours and during summer sessions. A school guardian is not required for after-hours school events and extracurricular activities. A school guardian is not required for off-school site activities during the normal school day, i.e. field trips, etc. It was motioned and properly seconded to approve the Safe-Schools Officer Policy. The policy was approved by the board for the 2026-2027 school year.
- V. Board Meeting Dates: Pre-planned dates of board meetings for the year were presented by Ms. Bailey. It was noted that Tuesday's is the best day of the week to schedule board meetings. She advised a two-week notification of change would have to be given to SDMC if there were changes to a meeting date.

- VI. Adjournment: The next meeting is scheduled for September 15, 2026 at 4:30 pm. It was motioned and seconded to adjourn the meeting. The meeting was adjourned at 1:41 p.m.
